## **Agreement for a Scholarship of Foundation Dare.**

1. Every year a student who finished the Kayoi Primary school, will be recommended to the Foundation for further education at a secondary school, and maybe later on to the University, by the school director of the Kayoi Primary school and Peter Kipkemboi Kimaiyo.
2. Selection criteria will be;
  - a. Very promising results at the Kayoi Primary school
  - b. Parents are unable to pay (enough) for the school fees.
  - c. The appropriate personal settings to make it a success.
3. The Foundation Dare will pay for the school fees of the secondary school. After good results also for the fees of an University can be paid for depending on the amount needed per year. Fees only, no other resources required for the study.
4. In order to finish Secondary school and University results will be needed each year. That's why we apply the strict rule; No results, No money! ...and we stop the scholarship.
5. At the end of each term, a copy of the results must be provided. And the student will have to hand in a personal report every year, containing a least a description of the last school year, situation at home and in your community and something personal. Either handed over to Peter, to the school director or preferably send by E-mail to the foundation.
6. In return for the scholarship we ask from each student that, after they finished the secondary school or if possible the University, they will propose a project of their own choice to either help the Kayoi Primary school or their community. The Foundation Dare, the director of the Kayoi Primary school and Peter Kipkemboi Kimaiyo will evaluate the proposed project on its suitability and check the actual operation.
